Please do not feel that you need to print this entire booklet. Tasks have been designed to be completed on plain/lined paper as much as possible.


All work should be sent to the class email and your current teacher will pass on the work to your new teacher. Any work on paper can also be kept to give to your current / new teacher in September.







7. Can you write a riddle for the class to solve? Could you give clues for your peers to guess a topic in Year 4, a memory or an event, a teacher or your peers?
